How to play:

Place your counter on the Start square. Roll a dice and move the relevant number of spaces.

If you land on an **animal** square, find out a fact about that animal. There are only four animals in this game – the Amur tiger, bharal, giant panda and the Steller's sea eagle but the squares are repeated four times so you may land on the same animal a number of times during the game. Each time, find out a different fact about the animal. Refer to the animal fact files. **Please note that the animal fact files have links to other resources for further information about the animals.**

If you land on a **threat** square, name a threat that is facing these animals. Each time you land on a threat square, name a different threat. Refer to the animal fact files. There is also an online [threats and solutions](#) game.

If you land on a **conservation** square, name a solution to the threats that the animals are facing. Each time you land on a conservation square, name a different solution. Refer to the solution matching game. Note: There is also an online [solutions game](#) with Mandarin translations.

If you land on a **language** square, try to say the name of one of the animals or threats in Mandarin. Each time you land on a language square, name a different animal or threat. Listen to the animal & threat sound files. Note: There is also an online language activity relating to the threats – [Threats in Chinese Characters](#) which is a shortened version of the [Chinese characters threats presentation](#).
