



Make a bird feeder!




You will need:

- a small pumpkin
- bird seed
- knife/carving tools
- rope/twine (optional)

Make sure you have an adult to help with cutting your pumpkin!

1. Cut your pumpkin

Cut the top off your pumpkin and hollow it out. Add a face if you like!




2. Make the hanger

If you want to hang your feeder, cut 4 opposite holes and add ropes.



3. Fill with seeds

Fill your pumpkin with bird seed!
Pumpkin seeds are safe for birds to eat, but they usually don't really like them!



4. Put it outside!

Hang or place your feeder outside.

When the pumpkin starts to go mouldy, make sure to put it in the compost bin to keep the birds safe.
