
Meet the

Create your own "Flextangle" to see the life cycles of our fabulous flamingos and roarsome raptors!



- 1. Score along all dotted lines (diagonal & vertical)
- 4. Fold all diagonal lines with white sides together
- 7. Bring tab C round and glue onto the back of the picture at point C
- 2. Cut out along the solid lines
- 5. Glue the back of point A to the white A tab
- 8. Bring tab D round and glue onto the back of the picture at point D
- 3. Fold all vertical lines with printed sides together
- 6. Glue the back of point B to the white B tab
- 9. Glue the back of point E to the white E tab.
