

¡Asombroso Armadillo!

This board game is designed for learning about the habitat, diet, biology, threats and breeding of the giant armadillo. The language cards add a fun element which use various language & literacy skills.


Question & answer cards

Language cards

Requirements (*not included*):

dice

6 x playing pieces



How to play:

Each player chooses a playing piece.

Each player takes it in turn to roll the dice and move the relevant number of spaces.

Follow any instructions which are given on the game board.

If a player lands on the question card squares, the player looks up the relevant topic (habitat, diet, claws, threats, length, burrows and breeding) from the question cards. The player reads out the question on the card. All players discuss. The player can then turn over to find the answer and some additional information.

If a player lands on the ¡Asombroso Armadillo! squares, the player has to pick one of the language cards. These have facts about the giant armadillo and also ask questions about how to say some words in Spanish. The player asks the rest of the team to answer because the answers are on the bottom of the cards.

Blank squares are useful for the teacher to ensure all the activities in the game are covered. Use these squares as 'chance' squares and make up scenarios in order to move on to squares you want the pupil to go. For example, '*name the colour of this square in Spanish and you can move on (or move back) 'x' squares*'. Alternatively for a quicker game, blank squares can just mean blank squares.
