Giraffe necks & Tiger tails - How to Play

Downloads required – Giraffe necks & Tiger tails gameboard; question and fact cards.

Other requirements - dice and counters

This game is based on snakes and ladders.

Start at square number 1 and roll the dice. Move the number of squares shown on the dice.

If you land on a giraffe neck, you go up the board.

If you land on a tiger tail, you go down the board.

If you land on a question card square, pick one of the question cards. If you get the answer correct, move on one square. If you answer incorrectly, miss a turn. The questions are all about colours so that you can practise your colours in German.

If you land on a fact card square, pick one of the fact cards. You will then learn a fact about one of the animals at Edinburgh Zoo!
