Anteaters, Armadillos & Sloths - How to Play

Downloads required – Anteaters, Armadillos & Sloths game board; question cards

Other requirements – dice and counters (preferably a Spanish language dice)

- Start at square 'El principio' and roll the dice. Move the number of squares shown on the dice.
- If you land on a question mark, pick up one of the question cards. If you get the answer correct, move on one square. If you answer incorrectly, move back one square.
- If you land on a picture square, act like that animal!

Picture 1 – sloth eating upside down - try to eat something (or pretend to eat something) with your head up!

Picture 2 – baby giant anteater – walk on all fours with a soft toy (baby) on your back – don't drop your baby!

Picture 3 – giant armadillo burrowing – pretend to burrow with large claws.

Picture 4 – sloth hanging upside down – try to imagine hanging upside down, lie on the floor on your back!

Picture 5 – giant armadillo using its great sense of smell – sniff along the floor as if you were an armadillo!

Picture 6 – giant anteater knuckle walking – try to knuckle walk like a giant anteater!

Picture 7 – sleeping sloth – sleep very still like a sloth!

• If you land on the Spanish squares – try to read and translate the words of encouragement.

Translations:

- ¡ Qué interesante! How interesting
- ¡ Bien hecho chicos! Well done guys
- ; Muy bien! Very good
- ; Excelente! Excellent
- ¡ Buen trabajo! Good work!
