	Beach or river clean ups.	Look up your local waste services.
	Get lobbying.	Just find out who your local MP is and write a letter.
	Class or group recycling project.	Don't through it away! Ask yourself if you can reuse the paper, plastic or any item. Can you make something new from it?
FSC	Ask your school to buy FSC products – paper, books, furniture & shelving.	Look around for the FSC logo on the products you buy.
	Create a school garden. Plant trees and make bird feeders and bug hotels.	Remember you could also do this if you have a garden or an allotment.
	Don't waste water campaign.	Turn off taps, take a shower rather than a bath, water the garden with washing up water.
	Ask your school to think about where food is bought.	Support local shops with local products. Look for Fairtrade logo on some foods.
	Encourage a walk or cycle to school campaign.	If you are able to walk or cycle to school then do! If not, can you take the bus? Avoid getting places by car if possible.
-	School using less energy campaign.	Don't leave items plugged in or on standby. Switch of lights when you don't need them. Don't overfill a kettle.
	Class or group clothing swap.	Don't throw out old clothes. Give them to a charity or make something new from them.
