What country in the UK are wildcats now found in?

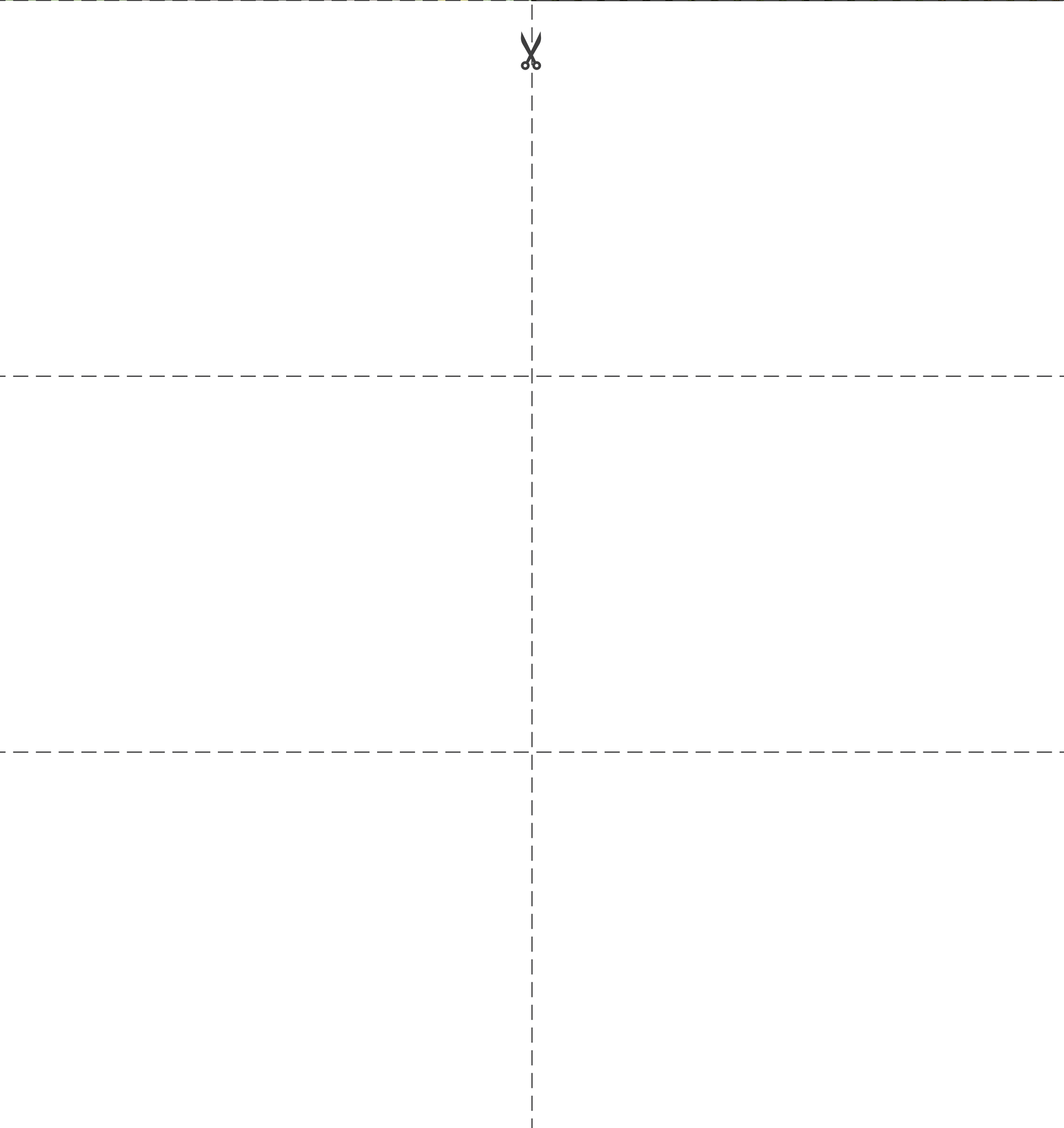
A. Ireland
