# Biomes and Animal Adaptations Teacher guidance



### **Overview:**

Our Biomes and Adaptions course, in collaboration with The Edina Trust, we have created a series of resources and sessions to engage primary school learners and educators both on-site at the park and within their primary school settings over 2025. The students will learn about Biomes and animal adaptions through both native and international conservation efforts exemplified by incredible animals in the stunning surroundings of the Cairngorms National Park

These lessons are designed to be teacher facilitated or self-led (age and stage dependent) and utilise our charity's virtual learning portal, ZOOdle (learning.rzss.org.uk).
