## What you may need for a mini-beast safari:

Suitable clothing—old shoes or welly boots (some of the best areas to look for mini-beasts is in the muddy areas).





Dress for the weather: Waterproof jacket/trousers, warm jumper/fleece or sun hat and sun cream

Equipment—collecting pots/old ice cream boxes, nets, white sheets, magnifying glass, animal ID list



## How to search for mini-beasts:

Use long handled nets to sweep through long grasses and bushes, shake a tree branch over a white sheet or look under logs and rocks.

Anything you find can be put into collecting pots or ice cream boxes for closer inspection. Once you have worked out what you have collected put it back where you found it.



Don't forget to leave the habitat as you found it.
