2. Learn more about your local wildlife and gain new skills. You'll be amazed at all the species living on your doorstep, and an annual Bioblitz is a great way to keep an eye on how they are doing.
3. Provide essential data for scientists and policy makers. Uploading your data to a national database will allow experts to monitor trends and help guide planners and wildlife protection policy.
