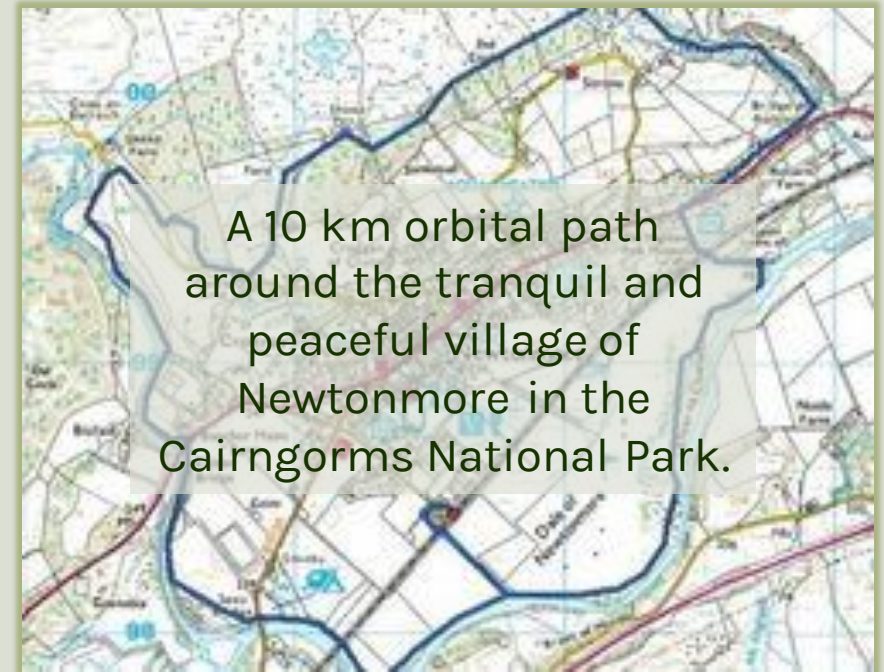


The Wildcat Experience

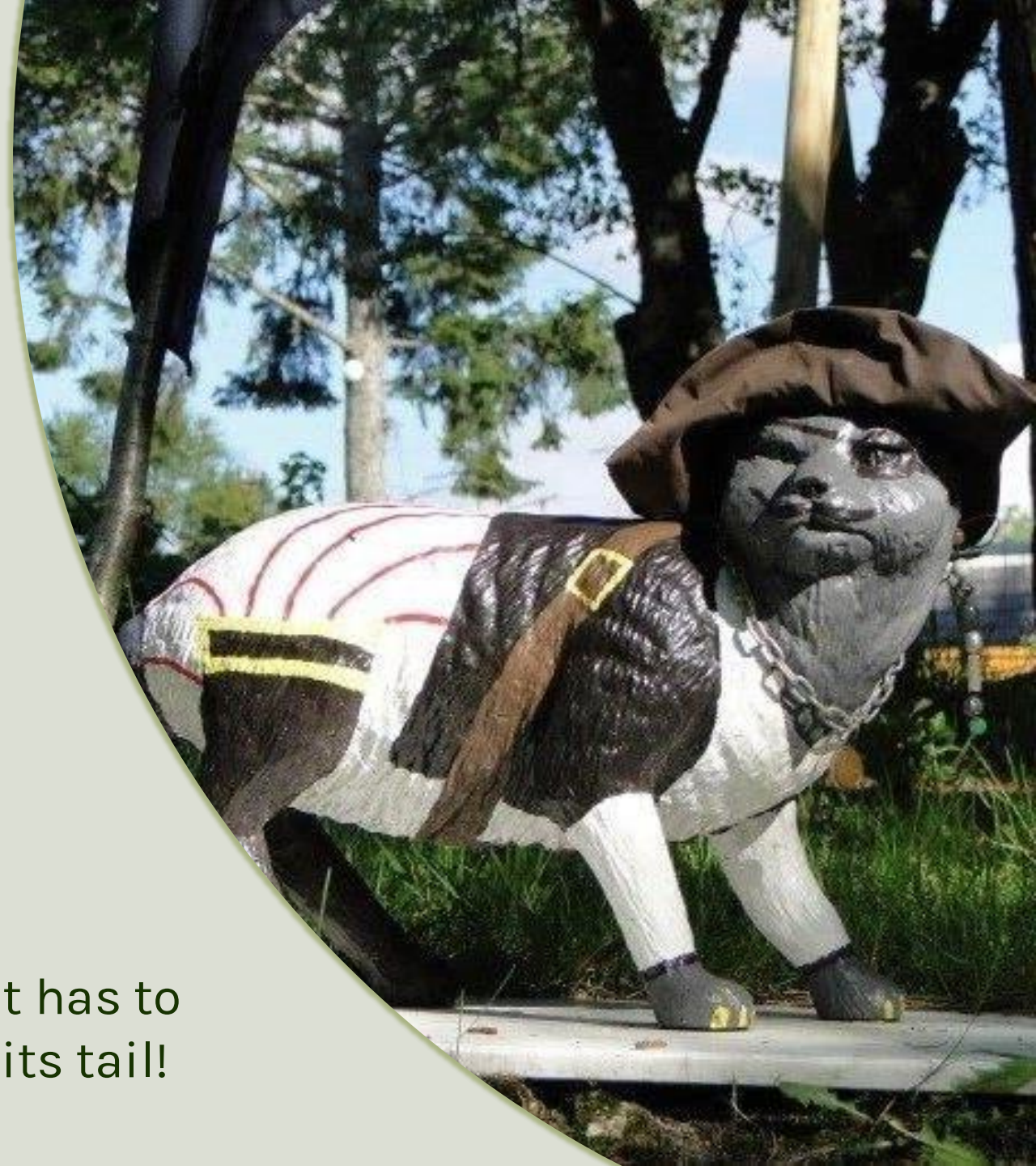


Wildcat art

- Your design could represent your school, area, family, team, club, favourite person, a historical character or a super hero, or anything else you can think of!

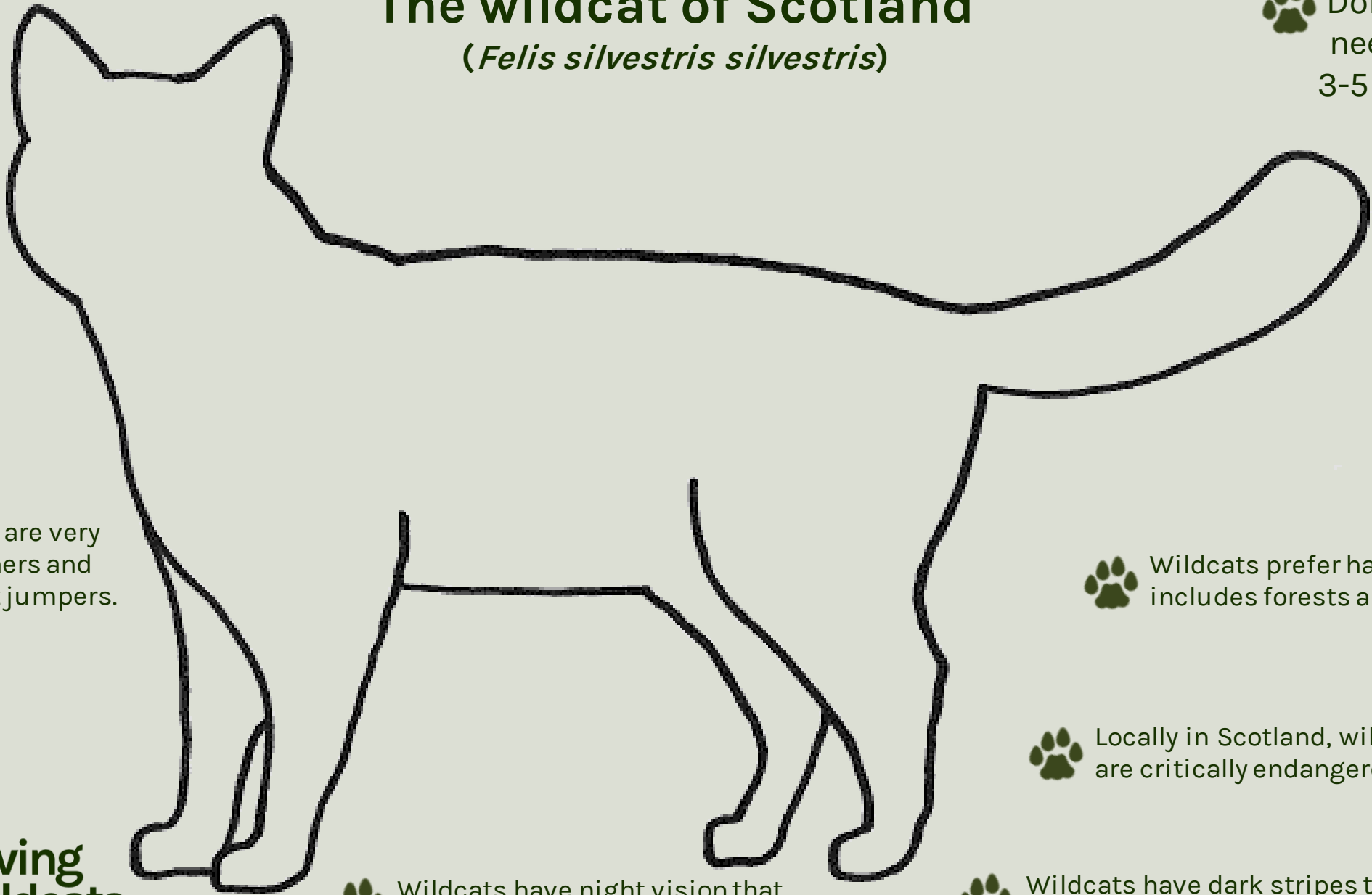
...but don't forget, it has to have 3-5 rings on its tail!

 Wildcats prefer habitat that includes forests and moorland.

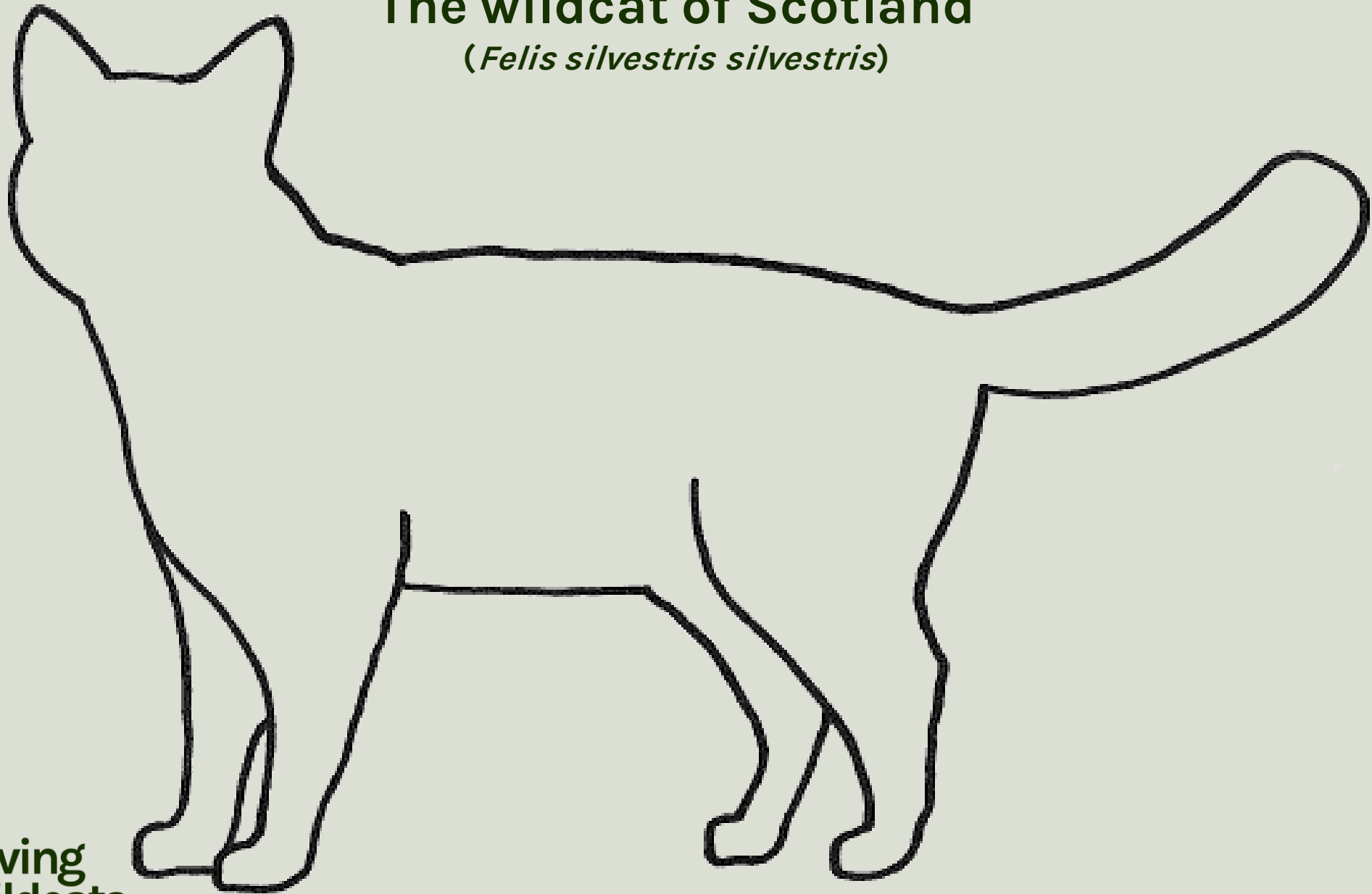
 Locally in Scotland, wildcats are critically endangered.
