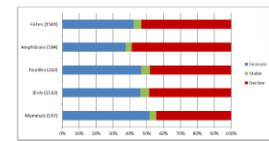
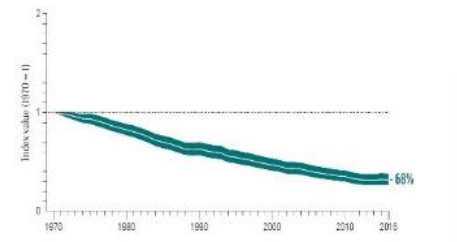


Figure 2: The proportion of species in each taxonomic group where the average trend is an increase, stable or a decline (WWF, 2018).
