### Key Learning Objectives:

#### 1. The pandas

- similarities and differences between the red and giant pandas
- life-cycles
- distribution
- Mandarin language – numbers; words for red and giant panda; words for big and small; writing and stroke order of characters. Part one of an introduction in Mandarin.

#### 2. Habitats

- habitats and animals of China
- adaptations and simple evolution of the hand
- carnivore, herbivore and omnivore
- Mandarin language - brief introduction to history of characters; format of some sentences. Part two of an introduction in Mandarin.

#### 3. Endangered species

- global threats and some solutions – focus on habitat loss; pollution; over-hunting and climate change
- IUCN scale for endangered animals
- Mandarin language – further investigation of characters. Part three of an introduction in Mandarin.
