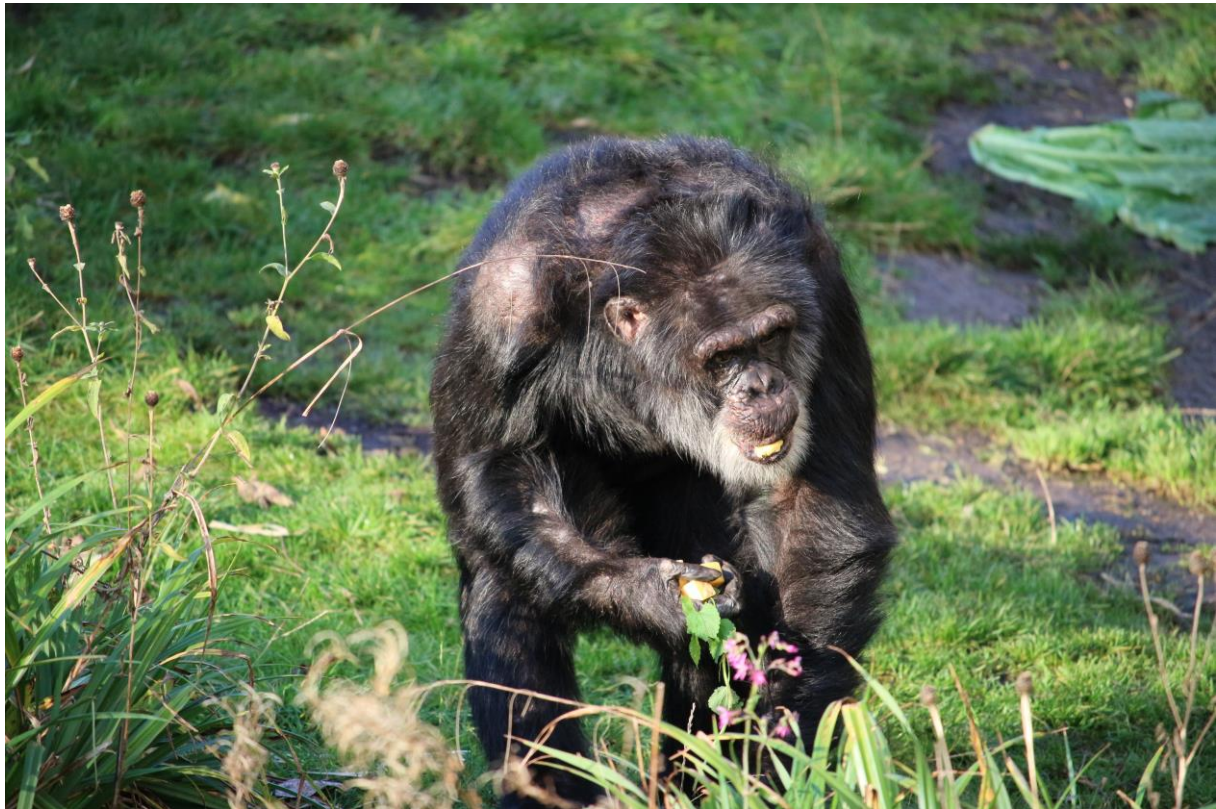
Asiatic lion
